## <u>OPINION</u>

Jack Schnitzer, doing business as Schnitzer Trucking Co., is engaged in the transportation of property in California pursuant to permits issued to him by this Commission.

Applicant seeks an order authorizing him to conduct service as a highway common carrier for the transportation of certain refrigerated and perishable commodities in the Los Angeles, San Francisco and San Diego territories.

It has come to the attention of the Commission that Mr. Schnitzer is in bankruptcy with proceedings pending in the United States District Court in Los Angeles. In view of these circumstances it appears that this applicant does not possess the financial resources to institute and maintain the operation sought to be authorized herein. The application will be denied.

## ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the application be and it hereby is denied.
