ORDER OF REVOCATION

Decision No. 52235 dated November 14, 1955, authorized Roy Jameson and Darol Jameson to transport, as a highway common carrier, certain specifically named commodities between the Los Angeles Territory, on the one hand, and the San Francisco Territory, and certain other points on U. S. Highway No. 101, on the other hand, and between various other points in central and northern California.

The Commission has been advised in writing, on behalf of Roy Jameson and Darol Jameson, that financial reverses have necessitated the termination of the Los Angeles operation which comprised by far the greater portion of the service and revenue. The Commission is requested therefore to revoke said certificate.

Good cause appearing, therefore,

IT IS ORDERED:

- (1) That the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted by Decision No. 52235, dated November 14, 1955, in Application No. 36006 is hereby revoked and canceled.

(2) That Roy Jameson and Darol Jameson shall cause to have canceled, on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public, tariffs governing the operations here involved.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
