ORDER

Tidewater Southern Railway Company is authorized to construct a track at grade across Moffat Road (Old U.S. Highway 99) near the City of Manteca, San Joaquin County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 75B-5.7-C. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the road now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding one percent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B) reflectorized with reflex-reflective sheet material. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

No train, motor, engine or car shall be operated over Crossing No. 75B-5.7-C without first having been brought to a stop and unless traffic on the highway be protected by a member of the train crew or other competent employee of applicant acting as flagman.

Suitable signs calling attention of trainmen to the above restrictions shall be erected at Crossing No. 75B-5.7-C.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
