OPINION AND ORDER

H. R. Hinsch is Agent of Central Territory Railroads Tariff Bureau. On July 2, 1958, he issued Supplement 17 to Freight Tariff 8-I naming car demurrage rules and charges on cars used in handling coal or coal products. The supplement was issued to become effective August 5, 1958, on statutory notice. By this application, authority is sought to change the effective date of Supplement 17 to August 6, 1958. Applicant asserts that due to delay in the mail, the supplement was not received by the Interstate Commerce Commission in time to observe the required statutory notice. He states that the Interstate Commerce Commission requested that an application be filed to postpone the effective date so as to provide proper statutory notice. Applicant also states that the sought authority is necessary to provide a uniform effective date for both intrastate and interstate application.

In the circumstances, it appears, and the Commission finds, that the sought change in effective date is justified. The authority will be granted. A public hearing is not necessary.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that H. R. Hinsch, Agent of Central Territory Railroads Tariff Bureau, is hereby authorized to change, on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public, by appropriate tariff filing, the effective date of Supplement 17 to Freight Tariff 8-I, ICC 4719, from August 5, 1958, to August 6, 1958.

This order shall become effective on the date hereof.
