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By this petition the California Dump Truck Cwners Association, Inc., secks, among other things, amendment of Minimum Rate Tariff No. 7 to revise the territorial limits of Los Angeles County Production Areas " $E$ " and " $G$ ", arcas from which minimum zonc rates have been prescribed for the transportction of rock, sand, gravel and related commodities in dump truck equipment.

Public hearings on the petition were held before Examiner C. S. Abernathy at Los Angeles on March 10 and April 21,
1956. Evidence in support of the proposed revisions was presented by applicant's manager.?

The record shows that the purpose of the soughe revision of Production Area " $F$ " is to include in the area a new facility of the Owl Rock Products Co. which has been constructed in Los Angeles County ecrritory to the north of Arrow Highway and to the east of Buena Vista Strect; the purpose of the revision of Production Area " $G$ " is to include in that arca the Kincaid facility of Ifivingston Rock Company, which facility is located to the southwest of the junction of Irwindale Avenue and Euntimgton Drive (Foothill Boulevard). Asscrtedly, question has arisen whether the described facilities arc, in fact, within Production Areas " $F$ " and " $G$ " respectively. By its proposals petitioner seeks revision of the tariff to eliminate such question in the future. According to petitioner's manager, the owl Rock and the Iivingston Rock facilities are so locatcd in relation to compcting rock products plants within Production Areas " $F$ " and " $G$ " that they should be accorded the same rates as those which apply from those production areas, respectively.

With reference to Production Area "F", revision of the area to exclude certain territory in the northern portion is also sought. Petitioner states that this portion of Production Area "F"

is devoted principally to residential uses, and that no rock: production facilities are located therein.

The Southern Coliforoia Rock Products Association supported the proposed revisions. No one appeared in opposition thereto.

To the extent that the proposed revisions would result in cnlargement of Production Areas "F" and " $G$ ", it appears that a strip of territory approximately one-holf mile wide ane two miles long would be added to the eastern portion of Production Area " $F$ ", and that a triangular area about one mile wide at the base and two miles long would be added to the western portion of Production Area " $G$ ". In the circumstances of record it is concluded and foume that the additions are reasomable and necessary to the maintenance of a nondiscriminatory zone rate structure for the transportation of rock products and related commodities from the areas involved. The exclusion from Production Area "F" of mon-rock producing territory as indicated aiso appears justified. The petition as it applies to the zone revisions will be granted.

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Based on the evidence of record and on the conclusions and findings in the preceding opinion,

IT IS REREBY ORLERED that Mimimum Rate Tariff No. 7 (Appendix "A" of Decision No. 32566, as amended) be and it is hereby further amended by incorporating thercin, to become effective

In all other respects said Decision No. 32566 shall
remain in full force and effect.
