FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, the Commission by Decision No. 56313, dated March 3, 1958, suspended to and including August 1, 1958 the certificates of public convenience and necessity of Arrow Pacific Drayage, a bankrupt corporation, and

WHEREAS, Curtis B. Danning, trustee in behalf of Arrow Pacific Drayage, is undertaking to dispose of the assets of the carrier, and

WHEREAS, it appears desirable to extend the period of suspension of the certificates for one month pending sale of the operative rights, now therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Order in Decision No. 56313, dated March 3, 1958, be, and it hereby is, modified so as to extend the period of suspension of the certificates of public convenience and necessity of Arrow Pacific Drayage to and including August 31, 1958.

The effective date of this first supplemental order shall be the date hereof.
