ORDER OF REVOCATION

Harry Barley has authority from this Commission to render service as a passenger stage corporation between Rio Nido and Guernewood Park, California, and intermediate points, from approximately June 1 to approximately September 9 of each year and to operate a sightseeing service over a route beginning and terminating in Guerneville and in its course passing by or through Armstrong Grove, The Big Trees, The Camping Grounds, Forest Rangers' Station and The Amphitheatre.

Harry Barley has permitted his public liability and property damage insurance to lapse. Investigation by a representative of the Transportation Division discloses that passenger stage service has been discontinued and discussion with Harry Barley indicates that he has no intention of resuming this service.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the certificates of public convenience and necessity granted by Decision No. 38694, dated February 19, 1946, in Application No. 27229 and in Decision No. 42302, dated December 14, 1948, in Application No. 29843 are hereby revoked. All effective tariffs and timetables on file with the Commission in the name of Harry Barley are hereby revoked and canceled.

The secretary of the Commission is hereby directed to cause a certified copy of this order to be served on Harry Barley in the manner prescribed by law.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
