O R D E R

City of Oakland proposes to improve Bancroft Avenue and in connection therewith proposes to construct and alter grade crossings by reconstructing, relocating, and adding new tracks at grade involving the Stonehurst Branch of Southern Pacific Company.

IT IS ORDERED that the City of Oakland is authorized to carry out the work shown in the application all being summarized in the following table with provisions for protection which shall be installed.

Width of all aforementioned crossings shall be not less than twenty-four feet with grades of approach not greater than two percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72.

Expense of construction and maintenance shall be borne in accordance with an agreement now being negotiated between the parties involved, and copy of said agreement shall be filed with the Commission within 180 days from the date hereof. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion such costs by subsequent order.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within two years unless time be extended or if conditions are not complied with. Authorization

may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
