FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

On January 7, 1958, the Commission issued its Decision No. 56039 in Case No. 5925 wherein it ordered William H. Nunnemaker and Clyde H. Nunnemaker to collect certain undercharges and also provided that if the undercharges remained uncollected eighty days after the effective date of the decision, respondents shall submit to the Commission on Monday of each week a report of the undercharges remaining to be collected and specifying the action taken to collect such charges and the result of such action, until such charges have been collected in full or until further order of the Commission.

Respondents have filed a petition for modification of this decision to provide that the required reports be filed with the Commission every ninety days rather than every week. It has been the Commission's recent practice with regard to such orders to require the carriers to submit their reports on the first Monday of each month. It is the Commission's opinion that this latter period is reasonable. The Commission is also of the opinion that this period of time should be uniform with respect to all carriers required to file such reports.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED:

1. That paragraph (4) of the order in the Commission's Decision No. 56039 in Case No. 5925 is hereby amended to read as follows:

(4) That in the event charges to be collected as provided in paragraph 3 of this order, or any part thereof, remain uncollected eighty days after the effective date of this order, respondents shall submit to the Commission on the first Monday of each month a report of the undercharges remaining to be collected and specifying the action taken to collect such charges and the result of such action, until such charges have been collected in full or until further order of the Commission.

2. That in all other respects Decision No. 56039 shall continue in full force and effect.

This decision shall become effective ten days after the date hereof.
