O P I N I O N

Harold Germo, doing business as G. & H. Fast Freight, is engaged in the transportation of property in California pursuant to permits issued to him by this Commission.

Applicant seeks an order authorizing him to conduct service as a highway common carrier for the transportation of general commodities in the Los Angeles Drayage Area and the San Diego Territory. Public hearing on this matter was held in Los Angeles on March 10, 1958.

The record does not establish that this carrier possesses the financial resources to institute and maintain the proposed operation. The application will be denied.
