FINAL ORDER

IT APPEARING that the Commission on July 31, 1956 by Decision No. 53521 issued an Interim Opinion and Order in Case No. 5679 which provided that Sunshine Water Company should not provide service to any new customers or additional subdivisions unless or until otherwise ordered by the Commission, and

IT FURTHER APPEARING that by Decision No. 54881, dated April 22, 1957, in Application No. 38792, the Commission authorized Southern California Water Company to purchase the public utility property of the Sunshine Water Company and which order further provided that Southern California Water Company should become responsible for compliance with the provisions of Decision No. 53521, and

IT FURTHER APPEARING that the Commission by Decision No. 56247, dated February 18, 1958, in Application No. 38792, modified Decision No. 54881 so that Southern California Water Company was relieved of the duty of complying with the above-mentioned provision in Decision No. 53521, and

IT FURTHER APPEARING that Decision No. 53521 recited it was interim in nature and that a final order would be issued, Now Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the complaint in Case No. 5679 is dismissed.
