ORDER DISMISSING REHEARING

By Decision No. 55075, dated June 4, 1957, in the above numbered proceeding the Commission amended Minimum Rate Tariff No. 7 to establish zone rates for the transportation of decomposed granite and related commodities from a production area in the Santa Monica Mountains to certain delivery zones in Los Angeles County. Said rates were established in response to a petition of the California Dump Truck Owners Association, Inc. that zone rates be made to apply from an area from which it was anticipated that several hundred thousand tons of decomposed granite would be shipped by one Walter Wuesthoff.

On June 14, 1957, Walter Wuesthoff petitioned for rehearing of the matter, alleging in effect that in certain respects the zone rates which were prescribed are unreasonable. On June 25, 1957,

the Commission issued an order, Decision No. 55179, suspending the assailed rates. Subsequently, on July 9, 1957, it issued a further order in the matter, granting the rehearing.

Pursuant to the latter order a rehearing was held before Examiner C. S. Abernathy at Los Angeles on June 24, 1958. At the rehearing counsel for Walter Wuesthoff stated that he was not prepared to proceed, and moved for a week's continuance of the matter on the grounds that the hearing had been set on short notice, and that witnesses who would submit essential testimony were not available, being out of the city. The motion was denied by the Examiner, and the matter was taken under submission for decision.

The history of this matter shows that for several months after the petition for rehearing was granted, the rehearing was deferred pending determination of what studies should be undertaken to support revision of the rates that were prescribed; that in September, 1957, Walter Wuesthoff suffered an incapacitating illness that lasted several months and caused a further deferral of the rehearing; that on January 31, 1958, it was brought to the attention of Wuesthoff's counsel that the matter should either be processed or dismissed; that on that date Wuesthoff's counsel stated that arrangements were being made to proceed; that information to this same effect was given by Wuesthoff's counsel on February 26, 1958, and that on May 23, 1958, an understanding was reached with said counsel that the matter would be brought to

hearing on June 24, 1958, or that it would be dismissed for want of prosecution.¹

As set forth in the petition for rehearing in this matter, Wuesthoff's purpose in seeking rehearing was to make certain studies and to submit evidence thereon which would justify revision of the rates prescribed by Decision No. 55075. Nevertheless, at the hearing on June 24, 1958, there was no indication that such studies have been made or that evidence relating thereto is available and would be presented if a continuance as sought were granted.

This matter has been pending for almost a year. It appears that Wuesthoff has had sufficient opportunity to arrange for the preparation of data to support his position. We are not persuaded that during this time he has made a sincere effort, consistent with his circumstances, to bring the matter to a conclusion with reasonable dispatch. The rehearing will be dismissed for want of prosecution. The Examiner's denial of the motion for a continuance is affirmed. When petitioner or any other interested party is ready to proceed, he may make an appropriate filing and the matter will receive consideration.

There appearing no good reason why the zone rates established by Decision No. 55075 should continue under suspension, said rates will be reinstated.

Assertedly, the counsel did not bring this understanding to Wuesthoff's attention, and he left the Los Angeles area shortly thereafter, not returning until about June 20, 1958.

Based on the record and on the conclusions and findings set forth above,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The rehearing of Decision No. 55075 is hereby dismissed for want of prosecution.
2. Minimum Rate Tariff No. 7 (Appendix "A" of Decision No. 32566, as amended) be and it is hereby further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective September 5, 1958, the supplement and the revised pages attached hereto and listed in Appendix "A" also attached hereto, which supplement, pages and appendix are made a part hereof by this reference.

In all other respects said Decision No. 32566, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
