## <u>O P I N I O N</u>

Byron Eames requests authority to sell his partnership interest in the Richards Trucking Company to his copartner, Frank G. Silva.

Applicants are presently engaged in the transportation of petroleum products as a petroleum irregular route carrier. The operative rights created by Decision No. 47683, as well as all other assets of the partnership, are to be transferred to Frank G. Silva for a cash consideration of \$5,000. For the year 1957 applicants realized a net profit of \$9,578.83.

After consideration the Commission is of the opinion that the proposed transfer would not be adverse to the public interest. A public hearing does not appear to be necessary.

## <u>O R D E R</u>

Application having been filed and the Commission being informed in the premises,

IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That on or before January 1, 1959, Frank G. Silva and Byron Eames, doing business as Richards Trucking Company, may sell and transfer, and Frank G. Silva may purchase and acquire, the operative rights granted in Decision No. 47683, dated September 16, 1952, in Application No. 31149.

(2) That within thirty days after the consummation of the transfer herein authorized, the purchaser shall notify the Commission, in writing, of that fact and within said period shall file with the Commission a true copy of any bill of sale or other instrument of transfer which may be executed to effect said transfer.

(3) That on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public, effective concurrently with the consummation of such transfer, applicants shall amend or reissue the tariffs on file with the Commission, naming rates, rules and regulations governing the operations here involved to show that Frank G. Silva and Byron Eames, doing business as Richards Trucking Company, has withdrawn or canceled, and Frank G. Silva, doing business as Richards Trucking Company, has adopted or established as his own, said rates, rules and regulations. The tariff filings made pursuant to this order shall comply with the regulations governing the construction and filing of tariffs set forth in the Commission's General Order No. 80.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
