Decision No. 57127

BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the Matter of the Application of A. MEYERS and R. B. MEYERS, a partnership, doing business as WESTERN TRANSPORTATION COMPANY, for authority to sell and transfer, and UNION PACIFIC MOTOR FREIGHT COMPANY, a corporation, for authority to purchase and acquire a certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing service as a highway carrier of property for Union Pacific Railroad Company between various points in Southern California.

O R D E R

Buyer and sellers having filed their application, jointly verified, therefor, the Commission being of the opinion and finding that there is nothing in the public interest to prevent the granting of the authority sought, and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That on or before October 31, 1958 A. Meyers and R. B. Meyers may sell to Union Pacific Motor Freight Company, a corporation, and Union Pacific Motor Freight Company may acquire, their operative rights as a highway common carrier created by Decision No. 41713, dated June 15, 1948, as modified by Decision No. 41919, dated August 3, 1948, both in application No. 29313.

(2) That applicants shall, within thirty days after completion of the transfer authorized by paragraph (1) of this order, report the fact of such completion to this Commission in writing, attaching to such report a copy of the instrument, or instruments, of transfer.

(3) That nothing in this order shall be construed to authorize the transfer of, or work an impairment or reduction of, the operating authority conferred upon A. Meyers and R. B. Meyers by Decision No. 54542, dated February 19, 1957, as modified by Decision No. 55030, dated May 21, 1957, both in Application No. 36495, or any part thereof.

(4) That the authority herein granted shall expire one year after the effective date hereof unless exercised within that time.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
