THIRD SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER
FURTHER MODIFYING DECISION NO. 51804

By this Third Supplemental Application, filed June 5, 1958, Sonoma Water & Irrigation Company, a corporation, requests that the Commission modify its order in Decision No. 51804, dated August 9, 1955, to authorize the utility to serve nine additional customers in an area known as West View Tract Subdivision stated to be owned by Domingo and Santina Gallo.

Applicant has entered into an agreement, dated May 15, 1958, and amended on May 31, 1958, with Domingo Gallo, acting for West View Tract Subdivision, providing for the extension of distribution facilities to furnish the proposed service. A copy of both the original agreement and the amendment are attached to the application. The agreement, as amended, is in accordance with applicant's filed Rule No. 15, Main Extensions, and conforms to applicant's sample form of subdivider's agreement on file with this Commission.

Applicant was directed by ordering paragraph 4 in Decision No. 51804 not to serve new or additional subdivisions within or adjacent to its service area without a showing satisfactory to the Commission that it had acquired sufficient quantities of water for

service to its existing customers as well as to such new additional subdivisions. By Decisions No. 53051, dated May 9, 1956, No. 53764, dated September 18, 1956, and No. 54445, dated January 29, 1957, the Commission has previously modified Decision No. 51804 to permit applicant to serve certain new subdivisions.

In this Third Supplemental Application applicant states that subsequent to the date of the Commission's Decision No. 51804 it has raised the rate of delivery of water to its system from 855 to 1,180 gallons per minute, not including the additional water developed to supply Belaire Unit No. 2 and Unit No. 3 of Belaire-Sonoma Subdivision (Decisions Nos. 53051 and 54445). Applicant also states that it has increased the capacities of its storage facilities from 568,000 gallons to 714,000 gallons and that it has installed mains of adequate size to deliver water through its system.

The Commission has considered the request of applicant and is of the opinion that applicant has made the necessary showing in support of its request for permission to extend service to nine additional customers within the West View Tract Subdivision, that a public hearing is not necessary, and that the application should be granted; therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that ordering paragraph 4 of Decision No. 51804 be and it is further modified by removing the subdivision service restriction therein contained to the extent of permitting Sonoma Water & Irrigation Company to furnish water service to nine lots within West View Tract Subdivision in accordance with the terms and conditions contained in its subdivision agreement with Domingo Gallo, a copy of which is attached to the application.

Except as modified by this order and by prior modifying orders issued subsequent to Decision No. 51804, the new or additional subdivision service restriction contained in ordering paragraph 4 of said decision shall otherwise be and remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
