

## ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE RIGHTS

By Decision No. 52172 dated November 1, 1955, in this proceeding, Airborne Flower & Freight Traffic, Inc., was granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a highway common carrier as defined in Section 213 of the Public Utilities Code for the transportation of certain specified commodities between certain points in the San Francisco Bay area, on the one hand, and San Francisco International Airport, on the other. Subsequently, the carrier changed its corporate name to Airborne Freight Corporation.

The carrier has not accepted the certificate nor filed a tariff. It appears that the certificate of public convenience and necessity should be revoked.


Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted to Airborne Flower & Freight Traffic, Inc., by Decision No. 52172 dated Novomber 1, 1955, is revoked.

The Secretary of the Commission is hereby directed to cause a certified copy of this order to be served upon Airborne Flower & Freight Traffic, Inc., and Airborne Freight Corporation in the manner prescribed by law.

The effective date of this order shall be the twentieth day after lawful service thereof unless Airborne Flower & Freight Traffic, Inc., or Airborne Freight Corporation before such effective date shall have filed with this Commission a written response

to this order denying the facts set forth herein and requesting a public hearing thereon, in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until a hearing is held and a further order is issued.
