Application of the County of Orange for authority to construct a grade crossing of Hermosa Drive across the Union Pacific Railroad track in the County of Orange, State of California.

## ORDER

The County of Orange is authorized to construct Hermosa Drive at grade across the Anaheim Branch of the Union Pacific Railroad Company within the County of Orange, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 3Y-11.8. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Union Pacific Railroad Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than 36 feet and grades of approach not greater than six per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not

complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
