ORDER

The County of San Bernardino is authorized to construct Haven Avenue at grade across the main track of Pacific Electric Railway Company's San Bernardino Line, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 6T-40.70. Construction costs shall be borne in accordance with an agreement being negotiated, and a copy of said executed agreement shall be filed with the Commission within ninety days from the effective date of the order. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the costs by further order. Maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails shall be borne by applicant and, between such lines, by Pacific Electric Railway Company. Width of crossing shall be not less than 40 feet and grades of approach not greater than three per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

Applicant declares that, in order to adhere to its project schedule, construction must be started at once, and for this reason has requested that the 20-day waiting period be waived. The effective date of this order is therefore the date hereof.
