O R D E R

The County of Fresno is authorized to construct James Road at grade across a track of Southern Pacific Company near Jamesan, in Fresno County, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. BA-184.8. Construction expense shall be apportioned by agreement between the parties or, if they fail to agree, by further order of the Commission. Maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails shall be borne by applicant. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing and grades of approach shall be as shown in the application. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals, (General Order No. 75-B).

Upon completion, Crossing No. BA-184.6 about 1,075 feet west shall be abandoned and closed. Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied

with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
