(2) That tarifi prubiscations authorized to bo mado by common carriers as a result of the order heroin may bo made offoctive on not less than Invo days' notice to the Comission and to the public if ifled not later than sixty days aftor tho offectivo dato of the tariff chonges heroin involved.

In all other rospocts said Docision No. 31606, as amendod, sholl remain in full force and effect.

This order shail bocomo offoctivo twonty days ofter the cate heroor.
