O P I N I O N

By this application filed March 13, 1958, three permits are sought to be transferred from a partnership, consisting of Troy M. Tullos and I. R. Maris to a newly formed corporation. The consideration is stated as \$3,000.

Public hearing was held before Examiner Rowe in Monterey on July 8, 1958, at which time evidence was adduced and the matter submitted for decision.

Although a protest was filed by six of applicants' competitors no one appeared at the hearing in opposition. From the evidence of record it appears and the Commission finds that the corporate applicant is financially able and will have sufficient operating equipment to carry on these permitted operations. Also, it is found that applicant Maris, who is the president and holds a large portion of the corporate stock and will act as manager of the business of the corporation, has had considerable transportation experience. The sum of \$1,000 has been paid in cash, the balance being payable in monthly installments of \$250 each. It is found

that the public interest will not be adversely affected by the proposed transfers.

O R D E R

Applications therefor having been filed, public hearing having been held, and the Commission finding that the statutory requirements have been complied with,

IT IS ORDERED that the transfer of the permits above enumerated is hereby approved and authorized.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that upon the filing of the corporate applicant of evidence of the liability protection required by the Public Utilities Code, said permits shall be transferred by the Secretary of this Commission.

The effective date of this order shall be ten days after the date hereof.
