OPINION

Key System Transit Lines, presently rendering a passenger stage service between and in various communities of the East Bay area in the County of Alameda and the County of Contra Costa, and between said counties and the City and County of San Francisco, requests authority to reroute a portion of its No. 91 Castro Valley-Redwood Road passenger line.

As justification applicant alleges that the proposed routing will better serve the area by providing direct service between the Castro Valley District area and the central business district of Hayward, as well as providing service to the newly developed retail and commercial area along Foothill Boulevard; that it will provide service to a portion of the residential area east of Redwood Road, north of Castro Valley Boulevard and along Redwood Road, north of Castro Valley Boulevard; and that applicant has received requests for the route changes as proposed.

After consideration the Commission is of the opinion and so finds that public convenience and necessity require the granting of the authority sought. A public hearing is not necessary.
