ORDER OF REVOCATION

Robert G. Hudgens has authority from this Commission to render service as a passenger stage corporation in and in the vicinity of Oroville and between such points and Thermalito, Palermo, and intermediate points.

On July 11, 1958, Robert G. Hudgens permitted his public liability and property insurance to lapse. By telephone call of July 15, 1958, Mrs. Robert G. Hudgens advised that passenger stage service had been discontinued, and that Mr. Hudgens had no intention of resuming this service.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted by Decision No. 55560, dated September 10, 1957, in Application No. 39196 is hereby revoked. All effective tariffs and timetables on file with the Commission in the name of Robert G. Hudgens are hereby revoked and cancelled.

The Secretary of the Commission is hereby directed to cause a certified copy of this order to be served on Robert G. Hudgens in the manner prescribed by law.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
