O R D E R

The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across Santa Fe Avenue in the City of Escondido, San Diego County, at the location described in the application. Applicant shall bear the entire construction and maintenance expense.

Santa Fe Avenue is not improved at the point of crossing, and this authority shall not be construed as authorizing the opening of said street across the spur track.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not

complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
