ORDER

The City of Lodi is authorized to construct a pedestrian crossing at grade across tracks of the Southern Pacific Company in San Joaquin County at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. DE-10⁴.3-D. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. The Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Construction shall be substantially as indicated in the application.

Width of crossing shall be not greater than ten feet and grades of approach shall be not greater than five percent. Protection shall be by one Standard No. 1 crossing sign (General Order No. 75-B); also by wing fences at each end of the walkway so constructed as to direct pedestrians onto the walkway; also by obstructing the walkway at each end with posts so placed as to compel bicycle riders to dismount; and also by installing a street light at the crossing.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing.

This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
