O P I N I O N

Applicant requests a restoration of two restrictions applicable only to its present service between San Diego, on the one hand, and Camp Cuyamaca and Camp Palomar, on the other hand.

Through inadvertance restrictions were omitted in the in lieu certificate granted in Decision No. 55090.

Said restrictions as now proposed will read as follows:

- (a) All passengers must be grade school pupils or children attending summer camps and attendant school or camp personnel, and must be destined to or originate at Camp Cuyamaca or Camp Palomar, and must embark or disembark at schools or other central loading points in areas served by the San Diego Transit System.
- (b) San Diego Transit System may refuse to render said service for less than a minimum of thirty (30) round-trip fares.

The application is not opposed and will be granted. A public hearing is not deemed necessary.

Application having been made, the Commission being fully advised in the premises, and good cause appearing,

CAMP CUYAMACA "ON CALL" SERVICE

From the various schools, via the shortest route to U. S. Highway 80, then via U. S. Highway 80 to its junction with California State Highway 79, then via California State Highway 79 to Camp Cuyamaca.

Restriction:

- (a) All passengers must be grade school pupils or children attending summer camps and attendant school or camp personnel, and must be destined to or originate at Camp Cuyamaca, and must embark or disembark at schools or other central loading points in the area served by the San Diego Transit System.
- (b) San Diego Transit System may refuse to render said service for less than a minimum of thirty (30) round-trip fares.

CAMP PALOMAR "ON CALL" SERVICE

From the various schools, via the shortest route to U. S. Highway 395, then via U. S. Highway 395, Grand Avenue in the City of Escondido, Valley Boulevard, and Valley Center Road to Rincon, then via California State Highway 76, Palomar Mountain Road, and State Park Road to Camp Palomar.

Restriction:

- (a) All passengers must be grade school pupils or children attending summer camps and attendant school or camp personnel, and must be destined to or originate at Camp Palomar, and must embark or disembark at schools or other central loading points in the area served by the San Diego Transit System.
- (b) San Diego Transit System may refuse to render said service for less than a minimum of thirty (30) round-trip fares.
