ORDER OF DISMISSAL

By this petition the California Dump Truck Owners Association seeks increases in the minimum rates which have been prescribed for the transportation of rock, sand, asphaltic concrete and related commodities in dump truck equipment between designated areas in Riverside and San Bernardino Counties.

The sought increases, insofar as they applied to the rates for asphaltic concrete, were granted by Decision No. 56625, dated April 29, 1958. In response to petitioner's request, consideration of the proposed increases in the rates for rock, sand and related commodities was deferred.

Petitioner has since filed Petition No. 44 in this proceeding by which it seeks a general readjustment of all of the minimum zone rates which have been prescribed for the transportation of rock, sand, and other commodities in dump truck equipment in southern California territory. In effect Petition No. 44 supersedes that portion of Petition No. 34 dealing with the rates for rock and sand. In the circumstances petitioner asks that the pending portion of Petition No. 34 be dismissed.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that that portion of Petition No. 34 in this proceeding upon which no action was taken by Decision No. 56625 be, and it hereby is, dismissed.
