O R D E R

The Western Pacific Railroad Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across an alley located between Capitol Avenue and "N" Street in the City of Sacramento, Sacramento County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. 4-138.32-D. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without super-elevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the alley now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with level grades of approach. Protection shall be by two existing Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B) reflectorized with reflex-reflecting sheet material. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

Applicant desires to proceed with construction as soon as possible and has requested immediate authorization.

THEREFORE, the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
