Key System Transit Lines requests authority to extend a portion of its No. 78 passenger stage line in the City of San Pablo.

Applicant alleges that while the existing route serves a large area in the northern portion of the City of Sam Pablo, it does not provide a convenient service for those persons residing beyond the present terminus of 11th Street and Broadway; that the proposed extension would provide service to a new residential area, known as Leroy Heights, as well as an old established residential area, known as Parchester Village; that it has received many requests from the City of Sam Pablo and residents of the proposed extended area for such service.

After consideration the Commission is of the opinion and so finds that public convenience and necessity require the granting of the authority sought. A public hearing is not necessary.

ORDER

Application having been filed and the Commission being informed in the premises,

IT IS ORDERED:

1. That a certificate of public convenience and necessity is hereby granted to Key System Transit Lines authorizing the transportation of passengers as a passenger stage corporation on the following streets in the City of San Pablo:

On 11th Street between Broadway and John Avenue On Stanton Avenue between 11th Street and Giant Road On Giant Road between Stanton Avenue and John Avenue On John Avenue between Giant Road and 11th Street

2. That within thirty days after the effective date hereof, applicant shall file a written acceptance of the certificate herein granted.
