O R D E R

Ventura County Railway Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across Patterson Road in Ventura County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 45C-3.50-C.

Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without super-elevation and of a minimum width of 24 feet, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding five percent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B) with reflex reflecting sheet material.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with.

Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The applicant advised the industry to be served is in urgent need of rail service therefore the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
