O R D E R

County of Contra Costa is authorized to construct Cervato Drive at grade across a track of Southern Pacific Company near Alamo, Contra Costa County, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. BO-50.8. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than thirty-six feet and grades of approach not greater than one percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (G. O. No. 75-B), reflectorized with reflex-reflecting sheet material.

Upon completion, a private grade crossing at M. P. 50.86 known as Diablo Vista about 500 feet easterly shall be abandoned and closed by railroad.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless

time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. Applicant desires to begin construction as soon as possible and has requested immediate authority. Therefore, the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
