O R D E R

The County of Los Angeles is authorized to construct Gage Avenue at grade across Pacific Electric Railway Company's La Habra Line in Los Angeles County, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. 6C-11.05. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Pacific Electric Railway Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than 68 feet and grades of approach not greater than five percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72. Protection shall be by 2 Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (G. O. No. 75-B).

Upon completion, Crossing No. 6C-11.10 (Gage Avenue) about 250 feet easterly shall be abandoned and closed. Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may

be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
