O R D E R

The verified application of Southern Pacific Company filed on August 8, 1958 discloses that no passenger or freight business has been transacted at applicant's station of Pitbridge, Shasta County, during the past five years and that continued maintenance thereof is not necessary.

It being found that public convenience and necessity no longer requires the maintenance of such service at the existing degree, Southern Pacific Company is authorized to abandon its non-agency station of Pitbridge, County of Shasta; to eliminate said name from its station records; and to cancel all tariffs and time schedules applying at said station on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and the public. Such tariff changes shall quote this decision number as the requisite authority. This order shall not be construed as authorization to increase rates or charges.

Within thirty days after abandonment as authorized herein, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
