ORDER

The City of El Paso de Robles is authorized to construct Twenty-fourth Street at separated grades over track of the Southern Pacific Company in the City of El Paso de Robles, San Luis Obispo County, at the location as shown by map (Exhibit A) attached to the application, to be identified as Crossing No. E-215.0-A. Construction shall be substantially as indicated in the application. Construction and maintenance expense shall be borne in accordance with an agreement to be entered into between the parties relative thereto, and copy of said agreement, together with plans of said crossing approved by the Southern Pacific Company, shall be filed with the Commission within 180 days from the date hereof. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the cost of construction and maintenance by further order. Clearances shall conform to the provisions of General Order No. 26-D.

Upon completion of the overpass, Crossing No. E-214.9, Twenty-sixth Street crossing at grade, shall be abandoned and closed to public use.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This

authorization shall expire if not exercised within two years unless time be extended or if conditions are not complied with. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
