 section of Beale Avenue and East Truxtun Avenue on)
 the East for the purpose of providing a connecting)
 street between said two intersections across)
 said tracks, all of which streets and crossings)
 are in the City of Bakersfield, County of Kern,)
 State of California.)

ORDER

The Greater Bakersfield Separation of Grade District is authorized to construct the East Nineteenth - Truxtun Avenue connection at grade across tracks of The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company in the City of Bakersfield, Kern County, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. 2-885.77. Construction expense shall be apportioned by agreement between the parties or, if they fail to agree, by further order of the Commission. Maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails shall be borne by applicant. Width of crossing and grade of approach shall be as indicated in the application. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B) equipped with automatic gate arms.

Upon completion, Crossings Nos. 2-886.0, 2-885.9 and 2-885.8, East Truxtun and Kern Streets, East Eighteenth Street, and

King Street ,respectively, in the vicinity of the new crossing shall be abandoned and closed to public use. Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within two years unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
