O P I N I O N

Key System Transit Lines requests authority to discontinue passenger stage service via its "J" Line between San Francisco and the Richmond Housing area.

Applicant alleges that in recent years use of the housing facilities have been discontinued; that at the present time there is one schedule to San Francisco in the morning and one from San Francisco in the evening. Each schedule averages approximately five passengers. Local service will continue to be available along that portion of route of the "J" Line to be discontinued where no other transbay line operates, so that the five passengers may still travel transbay by transfer to and from the "L" Richmond transbay line.

Attached to the application is a copy of a letter from the City Manager of Richmond indicating that said city has no objection to the proposed discontinuance of service.

After consideration the Commission is of the opinion and finds that public convenience and necessity no longer require continuance of service between San Francisco and the Richmond Housing area. A public hearing is not necessary.

O R D E R

Application having been filed and the Commission being informed in the premises,

IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That applicant is hereby authorized to discontinue service on its "J" Line between San Francisco and the Richmond Housing area.

(2) That on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public applicant shall amend its tariffs and timetables presently on file with this Commission to reflect the authority herein granted.

(3) That the authority herein granted shall expire if not exercised within sixty days after the effective date hereof.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
