In the Matter of the Application of WEST COAST WHARF & STORAGE COMPANY, a California corporation, for an Order authorizing it to discontinue its operations and to dissolve.

SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Taylor Milling Company operates a public utility warehouse in the City of Oakland for the storage of grain and grain products under a certificate of public convenience and necessity granted by Decision No. 29046, dated August 17, 1936, in Application No. 20487, and transferred to it by Decision No. 56299 dated March 3, 1958, in Application No. 39736. It also operates a public utility warehouse for the storage of grain and grain products in the City of Stockton.

The Company has informed the Commission that on June 2, 1958, Taylor Milling Company amended its articles of incorporation by changing its corporate name to West Coast Checkerboard Elevator Company. Tariff revisions have been filed under the new name. Accordingly, its certificates will be amended to show the new corporate name. A public hearing is not necessary.

Therefore, good cause appearing,


IT IS ORDERED that Decision No. 56299 dated March 3, 1958, in Application No. 39736, is hereby amended by substituting "West


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
Coast Checkerboard Elevator Company" in the place of "Taylor Milling Company."
