O R D E R

The Greyhound Corporation has requested that an order be issued authorizing the installation of "exempt signs" at Crossing No. C-337.4-C, the intersection of State Route 3 (U.S. 99) with tracks of Southern Pacific Company near the City of Mt. Shasta, Siskiyou County.

It appears that the two tracks involved are classified as a wye (spur) track and a spur track, as indicated in Section 576 (d) of the Vehicle Code. The wye track is used by McCloud River Railroad Company to turn snow removal equipment during the winter months. The railroads involved and the State of California, Department of Public Works, have no objection to the granting of this application. Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that approval is hereby granted to install "exempt signs" (Vehicle Code Section 576 (d,e)) at the subject grade crossing.

Such signs shall comply with Sections 16.05 and 10.05 of General Orders Nos. 98 and 99, respectively, and shall be erected and maintained by the proper authorities. If any sign is removed or the view thereof obstructed, the driver of any vehicle as described in Section 576 (a) (Vehicle Code) shall comply with the requirements of Section 576 (a) (Vehicle Code) as prescribed for grade crossing locations without "exempt signs". Within thirty days after erection

of such signs applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing.
This approval does not exempt any vehicle operator from the observance of any provision of the Vehicle Code and shall lapse if signs are not displayed within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Approval may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require.

This order shall be effective immediately.
