ORDER SUSPENDING OPERATIVE RIGHTS

By Decision No. 49555 dated January 12, 1954, Oil Carriers, Inc., acquired a certificate of public convenience and necessity which authorized the operation as a petroleum irregular route carrier for the transportation of petroleum and petroleum products in tank trucks and tank trailers between all points and places in the State of California.

Oil Carriers, Inc., has informed the Commission in writing that it discontinued operations July 31, 1958. The carrier requests that it be allowed a reasonable time within which to dispose of the certificate. A one-year suspension will be granted.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED:


(1) That the certificate of public convenience and necessity acquired by Oil Carriers, Inc., by authority of Decision No. 49555 dated January 12, 1954, in Application No. 35024 is hereby suspended for one year after the effective date of this order.

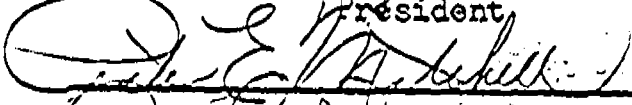
(2) That Western Motor Tariff Bureau, Inc., is hereby authorized and directed to suspend until one year after the effective date of this order, on not less than five days' notice, the

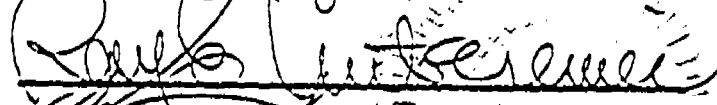
participation of Oil Carriers, Inc., from its tariffs on file with this Commission and that a copy of this order be forthwith served upon W. J. Knoell, Tariff Publishing Officer for Western Motor Tariff Bureau, Inc., Agent, as agent for Oil Carriers, Inc., as party to the aforesaid tariffs.


The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.

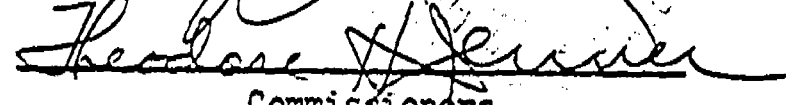
