ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE RIGHTS

Applicant accepted the certificate on July 23, 1957, and has received three extensions of time to file tariffs and establish the service. The latest extension of time expired August 1, 1958.

Applicant has written the Commission surrendering the operating rights granted by Decision No. 54750. It appears that the certificate should be revoked.

IT IS RDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted to Pacific Messenger Service, Inc., a corporation, by Decision No. 54750 dated March 26, 1957, in Application No. 36339, is hereby revoked.
