ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE RIGHTS

By Decision No. 56034 dated December 30, 1957, in this proceeding, Russell Truck Company, a corporation, was granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a highway common carrier of general commodities between Los Angeles, Long Beach, Vernon, South Gate, Bellflower and Pasadena.¹

Russell Truck Company has not accepted this certificate nor filed tariffs pertaining thereto as required by Decision No. 56034. It has informed the Commission by letter that it will let these certificated rights lapse and will not use them. It appears that the certificate of public convenience and necessity should be revoked.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted to Russell Truck Company, a corporation, by Decision No. 56034 dated December 30, 1957, in Application No. 36478, is hereby revoked.

Russell Truck Company also has a certificate to operate as a highway common carrier of freight between Los Angeles and Los Angeles Harbor pursuant to Decision No. 35274 of April 21, 1942, in Application No. 24856. This certificate is not involved herein.

The secretary of the Commission is hereby directed to cause a certified copy of this order to be served upon Russell Truck Company in the manner prescribed by law.

The effective date of this order shall be the twentieth day after lawful service thereof unless Russell Truck Company before such effective date shall have filed with this Commission a written response to this order denying the facts set forth herein and requesting a public hearing thereon, in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until a hearing is held and a further order is issued.
