O R D E R

Tidewater Southern Railway Company is authorized to construct an additional spur track at grade across "C" Street and relocate a lead track at grade across "B" Street in the City of Turlock, Stanislaus County, at the locations described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. 75C-5.95-C over "C" Street and 75C-5.84-C over "B" Street, respectively. Construction of said crossings shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without super-elevation and of a width to conform to the portions of the streets now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding two percent. Protection shall be by existing Standard No. 1 signs plus one additional Standard No. 1 sign (General Order No. 75-B) at Crossing No. 75C-5.95-C over "C" Street and by existing Standard No. 1 signs at Crossing No. 75C-5.84-C over "B" Street. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with.

Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience,  
necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days  
after the date hereof.
