SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 57367 of September 29, 1958, in this proceeding, Albert C. Freeman was authorized to discontinue the operation of a cold storage warehouse at South San Francisco, concurrently with the commencement of said operation by General Cold Storage Co., a corporation. The order also authorized Albert C. Freeman to cancel his participation in tariffs on file with the Commission. General Cold Storage Co. proposed in the application to file a tariff of its own.

It has come to the Commission's attention that certain of the rates set forth in the proposed tariff would result in increases over current rates. Decision No. 57367 did not authorize General Cold Storage Co. to publish rates which result in increases in those currently maintained by Albert C. Freeman. To remove the possibility of misunderstanding in this respect, the order in Decision No. 57367 will be clarified. In view of Decision No. 57367 being effective on September 29, 1958, the following order will be made effective on the date hereof.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that Decision No. 57367 of September 29, 1958, in this proceeding, is hereby amended by the substitution of the following for Ordering Paragraph 1 thereof:

- A. 40391-AHS

"1. Albert C. Freeman, on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public, may discontinue and cease the operation of a cold storage warehouse at South San Francisco, California, concurrently with the commencement of said operation by General Cold Storage Co., a corporation, and the filing of a tariff with the Commission by the corporation containing rates, rules and regulations no higher in volume or effect than those currently maintained by Albert C. Freeman."

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the following Ordering Paragraph be added to Decision No. 57367, supra:

"42. No increases in rates and charges are authorized by this order."

This order shall become effective on the date hereof.
