## OPINION

Milton W. Zamboni, William D. Lightfoot and Jack E. Shaver, copartners doing business as ZLS Trucking, request authority to transfer the partnership interest of William D. Lightfoot, in a certificated highway common carrier operation, to Mary L. Lightfoot.

The copartners are presently authorized to transport lumber and forest products in the region of Redding (Decision No. 43424 in Application No. 29680 and Decision No. 41175 in Application No.28774). The proposed consideration is \$8,000. For the year ended December 31, 1956, the copartnership realized a net profit of \$44,072.38.

After consideration the Commission is of the opinion and so finds that the proposed transfer would not be adverse to the public interest. A public hearing is not necessary.

## ORDER

Application having been filed and the Commission being informed in the premises,

## IT IS ORDERED:

- 1. That on or before May 1, 1959, Milton W. Zamboni, William D. Lightfoot and Jack E. Shaver may sell and transfer, and Milton W. Zamboni, Mary L. Lightfoot and Jack E. Shaver may purchase and acquire, the operative rights and property referred to in the application.
- 2. That within thirty days after the consummation of the transfer herein authorized, Milton W. Zamboni, Mary L. Lightfoot and Jack E. Shaver shall notify the Commission, in writing, of that fact and within said period shall file with the Commission a true copy of any bill of sale or other instrument of transfer which may be executed to effect said transfer.
- 3. That on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public, effective concurrently with the consummation of such transfer, applicants shall amend or reissue the tariffs on file with the Commission, naming rates, rules and regulations governing the operations here involved to show that Milton W. Zamboni, William D. Lightfoot and Jack E. Shaver have withdrawn or canceled, and Milton W. Zamboni, Mary L. Lightfoot and Jack E. Shaver have adopted or established as their own, said rates, rules and regulations. The

tariff filings made pursuant to this order shall comply with the regulations governing the construction and filing of tariffs set forth in the Commission's General Order No. 80.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
