## ORDER REVOKING DECISION

The Commission, by Decision No. 53936, dated October 16, 1956, in the above-numbered proceeding, granted Little Dann Valley Utility Company, a corporation, a certificate of public convenience and necessity to construct and operate a public utility water system in the area described in the decision, but subject to certain conditions set forth in the decision.

Decision No. 53936, dated October 16, 1956, granting Little Dann Valley Utility Company a certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing the construction and operation of a public utility water system in the area delineated on Exhibit "D" attached to the application in this proceeding, be and it is hereby revoked;
- 2. The tariff schedules, including rates, rules and tariff service area map, on file for Little Dann Valley Utility Company be and they are hereby canceled.

The Secretary of the Commission is directed to cause a copy of the foregoing order to be mailed to each appearance of record in this proceeding.
