ORDER

Request for authority having been made in the above entitled application, filed September 23, 1958, and good cause appearing,

The Western Pacific Railroad Company and Southern Pacific Company are authorized, pursuant to provisions of General Order No. 75-B, to install and maintain automatic gate arms for operation in conjunction with the two existing Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (G. O. No. 75-B) providing protection at Crossing No. 4-12.2, the intersection of 77th Avenue and The Western Pacific Railroad Company's main line track as well as a joint drill track of The Western Pacific Railroad Company and Southern Pacific Company in Oakland, Alameda County.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicants shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with.

Having been informed that railroad signal forces will soon be available for this project, the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
