O R D E R

Los Angeles County Flood Control District, in connection with Storm Drain Project No. 8, is authorized to construct a temporary shoofly crossing at Dunlap Crossing Road on Southern Pacific Company's Puente Branch in Los Angeles County, at the location described in the application and as shown on the maps attached thereto, to be identified as Crossing No. BKA-503.21, and Southern Pacific Company is temporarily authorized to operate along such relocated alignment during the storm-drain construction. Width of crossing shall be not less than 24 feet and grades of approach not greater than three per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 1 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B) with reflex reflecting sheet material.

Upon completion of the storm-drain construction adjacent to Dunlap Crossing Road, trackage shall be restored to the former alignment at Crossing No. BKA-503.2 and trackage at Crossing No. BKA-503.21 shall be abandoned and removed, with pavement restored in the temporary track location across Dunlap Crossing Road.

Construction and maintenance expenses shall be borne by applicant. Maintenance costs outside of lines two feet outside of rails shall be borne by applicant and, between such lines, by railroad.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

Applicant declares that it is pressed for time in its construction program on this project and requests a waiver of the 20-day clause. The effective date of this order is therefore the date hereof.
