In the matter of the application of THE ATCHISON, TOPEKA AND SANTA FE RAILWAY COMPANY, a corporation, for authority to abandon its non-agency station and to remove its spur track at Don, County of San Diego, State of California.

ORDER

The verified application of The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company filed on October 30, 1958, discloses that no passenger or freight business has been transacted at applicant's station of Don, San Diego County, during the past five years and that continued maintenance thereof is not necessary.

It being found that public convenience and necessity no longer require the maintenance of such service, The Atchson, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company is authorized to abandon its non-agency station of Don, County of San Diego; to remove a spur track at said station; to eliminate said name from its station records; and to cancel all tariffs and time schedules applying at said station on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and the public. Such tariff changes shall quote this decision number as the requisite authority. This order shall not be construed as authorization to increase rates or charges.

Within thirty days after abandonment and removal of the spur track as authorized herein, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
