OPINION AND ORDER


On August 5, 1958, the Commission issued an order of investigation into the operations and practices of James R. Hughes as a licensed motor transportation broker. The investigation was instituted for the purpose of determining a number of matters among which was whether the respondent's license should be suspended or revoked.


Subsequent to the issuance of this order of investigation, the motor transportation broker's bond filed by the respondent was canceled by the surety company. The respondent has not filed any additional motor transportation broker's bond with the Commission. Therefore, pursuant to the provisions of Section 4840 of the Public Utilities Code, respondent's motor transportation broker's license has been terminated by operation of law. Such being the case, no purpose would be served by continuing the present investigation.

Therefore, good cause appearing, it is ordered that the investigation in Case No. 6164 is hereby discontinued.
