O P I N I O N

E. Guy Warren, doing business as Warren Transportation Company, and presently rendering service as a highway common carrier, requests that his certificated authority be amended so as to exclude dump truck service.

Applicant alleges that he is now engaged in the transportation of commodities requiring dump truck service and is competitive with carriers operating under permits; that his tariff is not designed for the assessment of rates for dump truck operations which constitute a highly specialized service; that his certificated rights are not state-wide and his dump truck operations may be within or without, or partially within or without the certificated area and that the Commission has recently excluded such operations from certificates because of the specialized nature of dump truck service.

After consideration the Commission is of the opinion that public convenience and necessity no longer require applicant's certificated dump truck service. A public hearing is not necessary.

ORDER

Application having been filed and the Commission being informed in the premises,

IT IS ORDERED that Decision No. 45417 as amended by Decisions Nos. 45792, 50499 and 53170 is hereby further amended by adding the following subparagraph to ordering paragraph (2) thereof:

- (g) Applicant shall not transport commodities in bulk in dump trucks or hopper-type trucks.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
